

A Line from Lex

We are now entering our 6th month dealing with the Covid-19 Virus. To say our world has changed is an understatement. I must be honest; I was extremely concerned with our churches closing that their financial situation would be in peril and as a result, Sarepta's financial status would be also. However, though we are not "out of the woods yet," the receipts from our Sarepta Churches are slightly above where we were in 2019 by just over \$1000. <u>I cannot tell you how grateful I am for your faithfulness to support the work of the association</u>. Though things have slowed down considerably, we have teams that are meeting regularly and ZOOM calls being made with different groups. We are still working with churches to assist with issues they are dealing with, along with trying to help two Hispanic churches (Athens and Jefferson) find a church facility where they can meet. The work goes on thanks to you and your support.

SPARK CONFERENCE (Formerly GO Georgia) "Pivot" is a word that has been used a lot during the pandemic. Usually associated with a move that a basketball player makes on the court, it has now gained traction in reference to changing directions from the intended path. That describes what the GBMB has done with the "in person" GO Georgia conference. They have "pivoted" to an "on line" experience that will premiere on August 29 with 3 keynote speakers and 50 breakout sessions. The registration is FREE if you register by August 28. You will have access to all the breakouts and keynote speakers for a three-week period of time. You can pay an additional modest fee to gain access for a year. Your association has registered and will have access to the training materials for a year. We hope to be able to make them available to our churches in various formats. However, you also can register as an individual or a church and do the same thing. Remember, register by August 28th.

LUNCH and LEARN – August 17 – This meeting was planned back in May and indications were, at that time, we were on the "down side" of the pandemic. NOT EXACTLY! In the past few weeks, we have observed a significant "spike" in confirmed cases of Covid-19 indicating that we are not near as close to the end as we thought. As a result, I will be canceling our August Lunch and Learn. I will continue to keep an eye on status of Covid-19 to determine what we will do from September onward.

Executive Committee Meeting – September 8 – ZOOM Meeting - In light of the unpredictable nature of the Covid-19 Pandemic, our Moderator, Brett Mask, and I have decided to not have an in-person Executive Committee but rather have a ZOOM meeting at **7 p.m. on Tuesday, September 8th.** The information will be sent to our pastors in advance, along with the invitation to participate. If you are a messenger from your church for the Executive Committee and do not receive an invitation to join the meeting, please let me know and I'll gladly send you the needed information and the invitation. Thanks for your patience as we try to adapt as we go to the limitations this pandemic has caused.

International Friends, like many ministries and schools, closed abruptly due to Covid-19, and we are now figuring out the "new normal." We have decided to go online for Fall semester, to protect both our students and our volunteers.

I have referred to this English teaching ministry as a "springboard" type of ministry. Students come to us to improve their English, we provide good English classes, and in turn have the relational and emotional collateral necessary to speak into their lives. Even during our shut down, the volunteers and I have been reaching out to our students, many of whom have endured monumental disruptions to their livelihood, their educational plans, and their immigration status. Some were literally stranded in the U.S., unable to go home.

Because of the trust built before anyone had heard of Covid-19, we have been able to reach out and show the love of Christ to many of these students, even while classes are not meeting. Sometimes reaching out is a simple phone call. Sometimes it is a visit, a well-timed monetary gift, or inviting someone to come live with your family for a while so they can afford their flight home. If we did not have these relationships established before this crisis began, we would not have the opportunity to minister in these ways.
