



A Line from Lex

A few months ago, my wife's family received word that her deceased father, Paul Box, is going to be inducted in the Baptist General Convention of Oklahoma's "Hall of Fame." My father-in-law pastored a number of churches in Oklahoma during his active ministry there. He spent 17 years pastoring FBC Moore which was one of the leading churches in the state. My in-laws were also missionaries in their early days planting a church in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia and later prior to retirement pastored International Baptist Church in Munich. After retirement, he was interim pastor in 13 churches throughout the state of Oklahoma. The state convention will be honoring the families of the inductees at the Oklahoma Baptist Convention in Mustang, OK the same week as our Georgia Baptist Convention. My wife and I will be traveling to Oklahoma to represent her family at this very significant occasion for our family. Having a father-in-law like him as a mentor was absolutely priceless to me as a pastor.

This will be our last newsletter of 2022! I want to express my gratitude to our Sarepta churches for the excellent way in which you have supported this ministry financially. Our giving this year has been up over the previous two years and we have had three churches re-engage in their support for Sarepta and its ministry this year. For that we are grateful.

Several "New" Things were started this year:

The Mission Georgia Team was formed and will be challenging our churches to get involved in caring for foster families.

"S.O.S." (Sharpening Our Saws) started this year. Upon polling our pastors, they expressed needs in the area of Pastoral Counseling and Sermon Preparation. The experience has been great by those who have participated.

Partnership Missions is not new but our partner is. Covid derailed our efforts in 2021 to travel to New Hampshire. I was able to go with about eleven others to Island Pond Baptist in Hampstead, NH in May for our first mission team to participate in their spring festival and prayer walking. Six of our churches were represented on the team.

The bi-vocational pastor pipeline is moving forward with the goal of equipping men to serve in

As we look forward to 2023, once again I will be surveying our pastors to see how we, as an association, can better meet needs. The "S.O.S." training is a direct result of the feedback I got last year from those who responded to the survey. We will be expanding our Partnership Missions involvement to include international partners in Peru. We will continue to partner with our GBMB missionaries to work together to meet the needs of our churches. I would encourage you to find ways to link arm in arm with us to advance the Kingdom of God.
