SPARK Conference - Saturday, August 26 at Beech Haven Baptist Church - Summer is practically upon us and before you know it, the summer will fly by. At the end of summer we have the largest event we will host this year. Partnering with the Georgia Baptist Mission Board and Beech Haven Baptist, we are helping sponsor an event for northeast Georgia. It will be an "in person" training event for virtually every conceivable leader and worker in your church. We will have the privilege of hearing Dr. Thom Rainer as the keynote speaker. Dr. Rainer was President of LifeWay, a former seminary professor, an author and a church growth consultant. He currently is the founder and CEO of Church Answers which is an online resource for pastors and leaders. He hosts a podcast called Rainer on Leadership. In addition to that there will be over 40 breakout sessions. If you signup and attend, you will receive access to the VAULT for a year which will contain many of the breakout sessions.
