There the candidate will be able to complete the application, attach his resume and see the job description. Applications will be open until early August.

At our May 1st Leadership Team Meeting, an Interview Team of six members were selected to evaluate the resumes and ultimately come up with a shortlist and begin an interview process. This interview consists of our Moderator, Shane Roberson (Maysville), our Vice Moderator, Matt Bartlett (Lexington) and the following who were selected by the team: Jim Patton (Comer), Barry Bray (Rogers), John Walker (Beech Haven), Mike Sarna (Meadow)

They will eventually bring back a recommendation to the entire Leadership Team for approval. Once the Leadership Team makes their decision, our new AMS will be selected.
